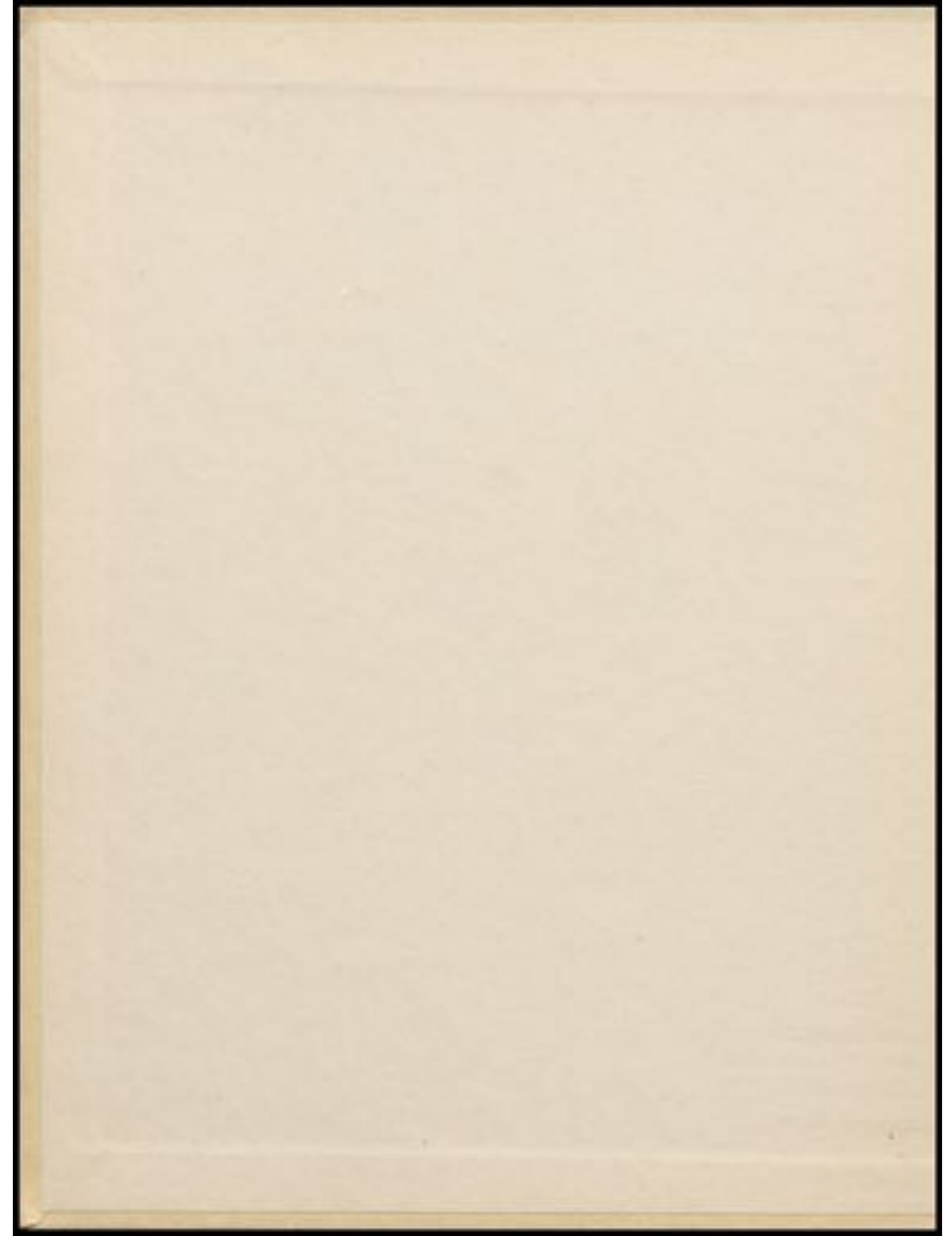


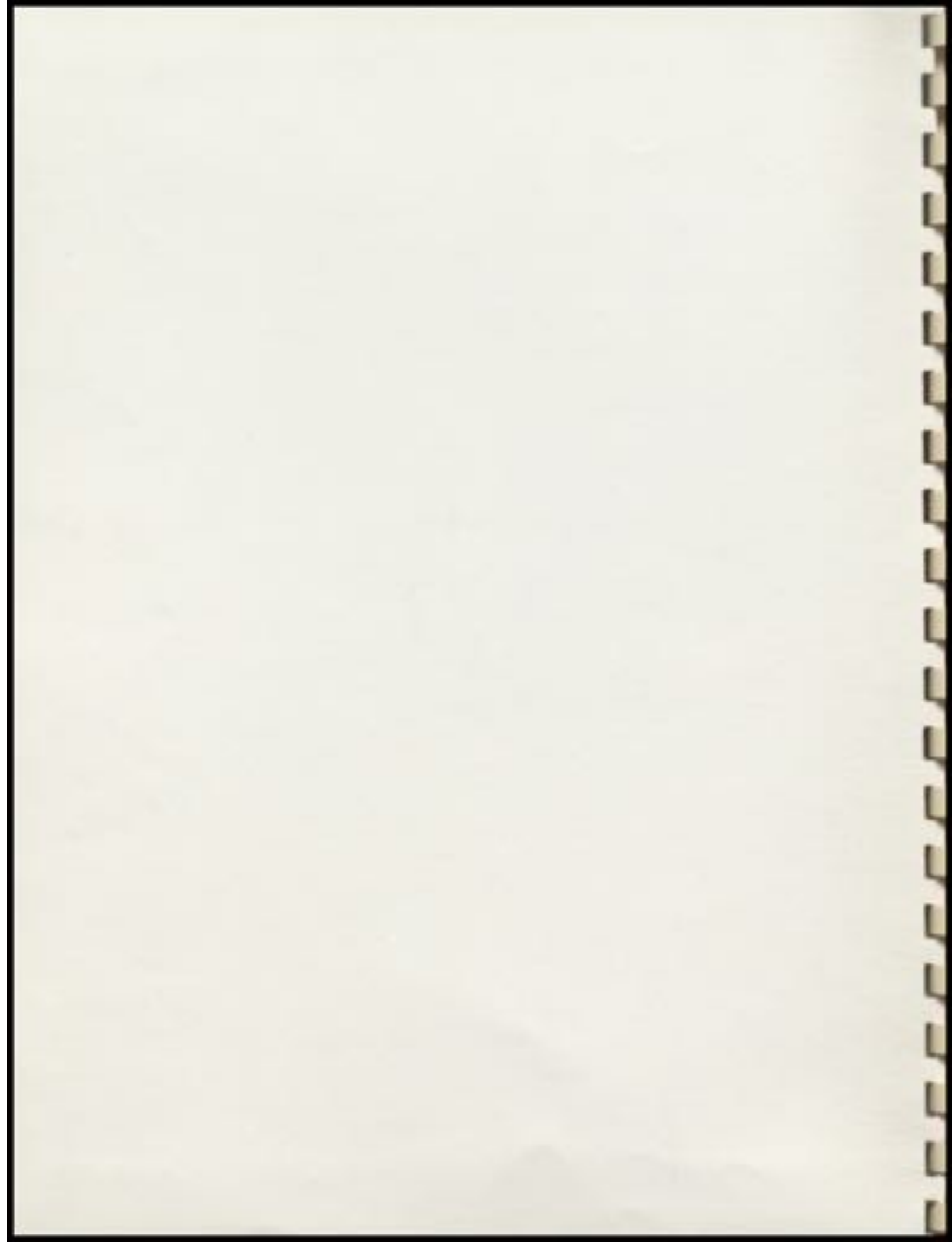

## Football

Winning eight out of nine games and scoring 328 points to seven for the opponents, the 1946 edition of the Trojan gridgers compiled one of the greatest records in Odebolt sports' history. The Trojans were undefeated, untied, unscored on, and had extended their win list to 20 consecutive games before losing to Holstein in the final game of the year, 7 to 6.

The 1946 season opened with an easy victory over Schaller, 52-0. Coach Forsythe used 34 players in this game, many seeing action for the first time. Correctionville was brushed aside 34-0 on a hot afternoon for Odebolt's second victory. Kingsley, booked as one of the toughest teams on the Odebolt schedule, was defeated 27 to 0 as the Trojans really began to roll. Next on the list of one-sided victories for Odebolt were Moville, Alta and Dunlap. Dunlap, the Homecoming opponent, put up a game fight but ended up on the short end, 47-0.

On the following Friday night, the Trojans journeyed to Sac City to take part in the

Homecoming activities there. The Trojans were not very hospitable in their style of proving that they were the kingpin of Sac county grid circles. Starting with a touchdown in the first minute of the game, the Trojans scalped the hapless Indians to the tune of 27-0. Wall Lake turned out to be a stubborn foe in the next game before bowing out 39 to 0.

After postponing the Armistice day game with Holstein because of deep snow on the Holstein field, the traditional contest between the rival schools was played on a Friday night during a downpour of rain on a slippery and muddy field. Outweighed at least 20 pounds per man, the muddy field and rain proved too much of a handicap and the Trojans had their perfect record spoiled along with their title hopes of the Maple Valley Conference championship when Holstein eked out a 7 to 6 win.

Bill Bye, co-captain, was named to the Fourth All-State team as fullback, and Don Rex, co-captain, John Swanson and Clyde Mey-

er received honorable mentions on the coveted list. The Trojan line in holding the opponents to seven points proved that it was the backbone of this fine team. The regular linemen were Earl Richardson and Bob Hansen, ends; John Swanson and Roger Kinney, tackles; Bill Kruusutjerna, center, and Clyde Meyer and Bob Schwallier, guards. This line was bolstered often and well by Don Olson, Kenneth Wingert, Dick Morr, Dick Stephens, Miron Johnson, Raymond Jeckell, John Bengford and Charles Bernhardt.

The backfield chores were handled by Bill Bye, Don Rex, Duane Thayer, John Swanson, Kenneth Bengford, Tom Summers, and Austin Babcock.

The Junior High and Second team also compiled fancy records to make this a banner year for Odelslet on the gridiron. The Second team turned back a tough Demson squad twice and the Junior gridgers won five out of seven contests. They claimed two victories over Correctionville, two over Rockwell City, and one over Ida Grove. They lost to Sac City and Ida Grove.
