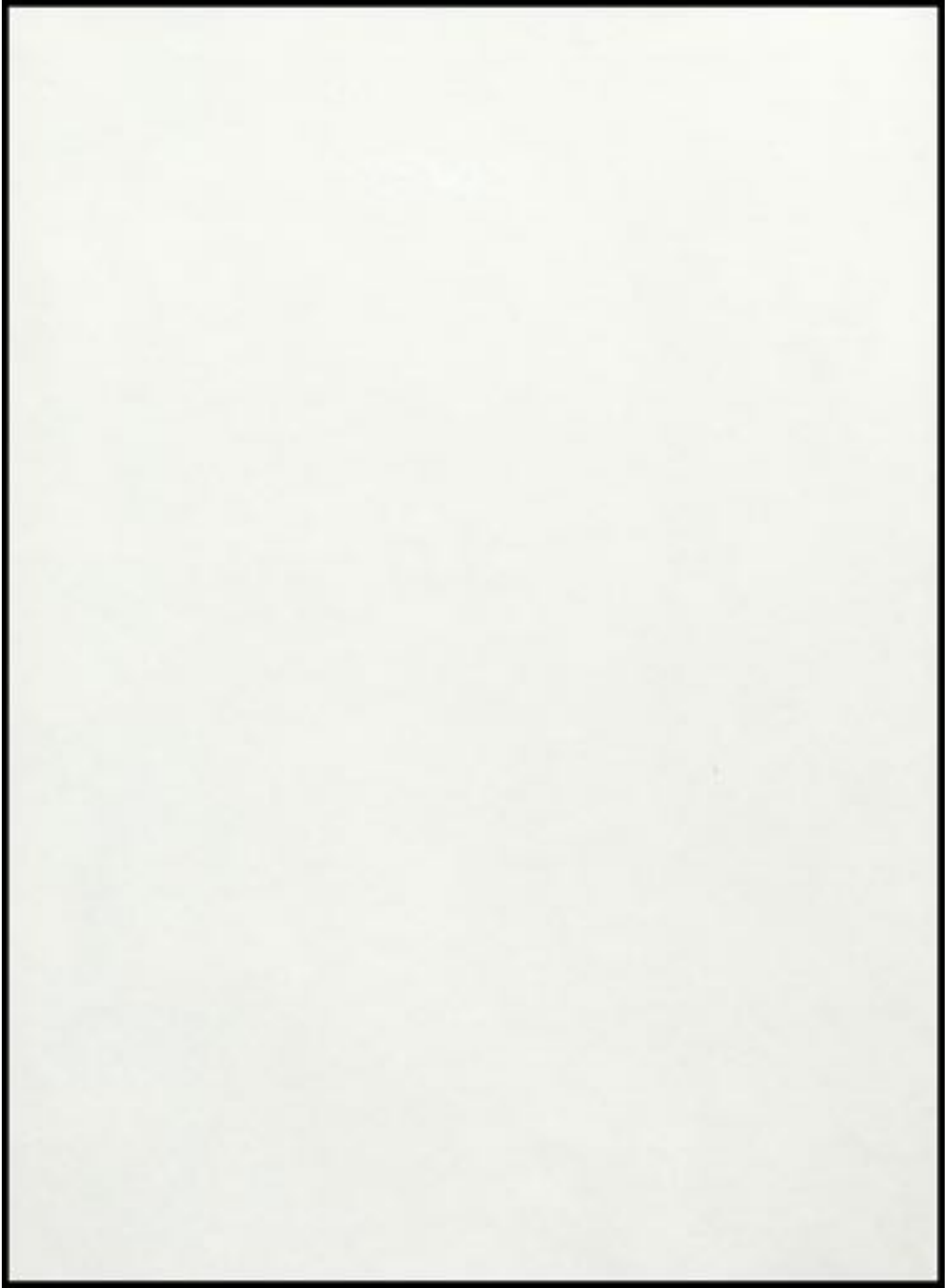

# Farewell to the Arthur Building

The first school building was built in 1897. It was a one story frame structure with two rooms. An addition and bell tower were later added. This building was used until 1913 when the new brick school was built. The gym was added in 1939 to the back of the building, and the three classrooms added to the west side were completed in 1955. Effective July 1, 1956, the Arthur high school closed, and the Odebolt and Arthur schools were reorganized into the Odebolt-Arthur Community School District. Since 1970, the Arthur building has housed the Odebolt-Arthur Middle School. Other new changes to the Arthur building have been the elimination of the old fire escape, some windows, and the new addition of a classroom to be used as a middle school special education room. Rodger Miller became the middle school principal in 1969 and continued in that capacity until his retirement in 1997. As noted in the Odebolt Quasiquicentennial, Mr. Miller was very innovative in creating new programs, both academic and non-academic areas, in the middle school. Many of his programs continue to flourish. He was a leader in the state of Iowa with his ideas and focus on the direction and role middle schools should take in the total educational plan.
